The purpose of this list of safety procedures, is to provide general safety precautions to be used by persons who own, install, operate, or maintain the systems described within this manual.

This list should not be used to replace instructions that are provided by the equipment manufacturer. Therefore, anyone attempting to work on any equipment, should be thoroughly familiar with the specific instructions for that particular unit.

The following is a list of the criteria that have been used here to indicate the intensity of the hazard:

DANGER - This means that there is an immediate hazard that will result in severe personal injury or death.

WARNING - This means that hazards or unsafe practices could result in severe personal injury or death.

CAUTION - This means that potential hazards or unsafe practices could result in minor personal injury.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS - These are general instructions that are necessary for safe working practices.
